

## Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) Order Information

### EPSDT/HCY Screening Guides

The State of Missouri's Healthy Children and Youth (HCY) Screening Guides are mandatory screening forms to be used when providers offer EPSDT/HCY screenings.

- For providers who use paper medical records, the HCY Screening Guides must be signed and dated by the provider and retained in the member's medical record.
- For providers who use electronic medical records, the HCY Screening Guides are not required, but all components of the Guides must be captured and easily accessible in the medical record.

The State of Missouri supplies the HCY Screening Guides at no cost to the provider. They can be downloaded from the MO HealthNet Division (MHD) website by using the following process:

### Growth Charts

Missouri Care recommends that growth charts be maintained in the medical record of children up to eighteen (18) years of age. Height, weight and head circumference must be plotted on children twelve (12) months and under; height and weight on children over twelve (12) months. Missouri Care also recommends that providers plot body mass index (BMI) beginning at age two (2). Providers may access clinical growth charts from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention website at the following location:
