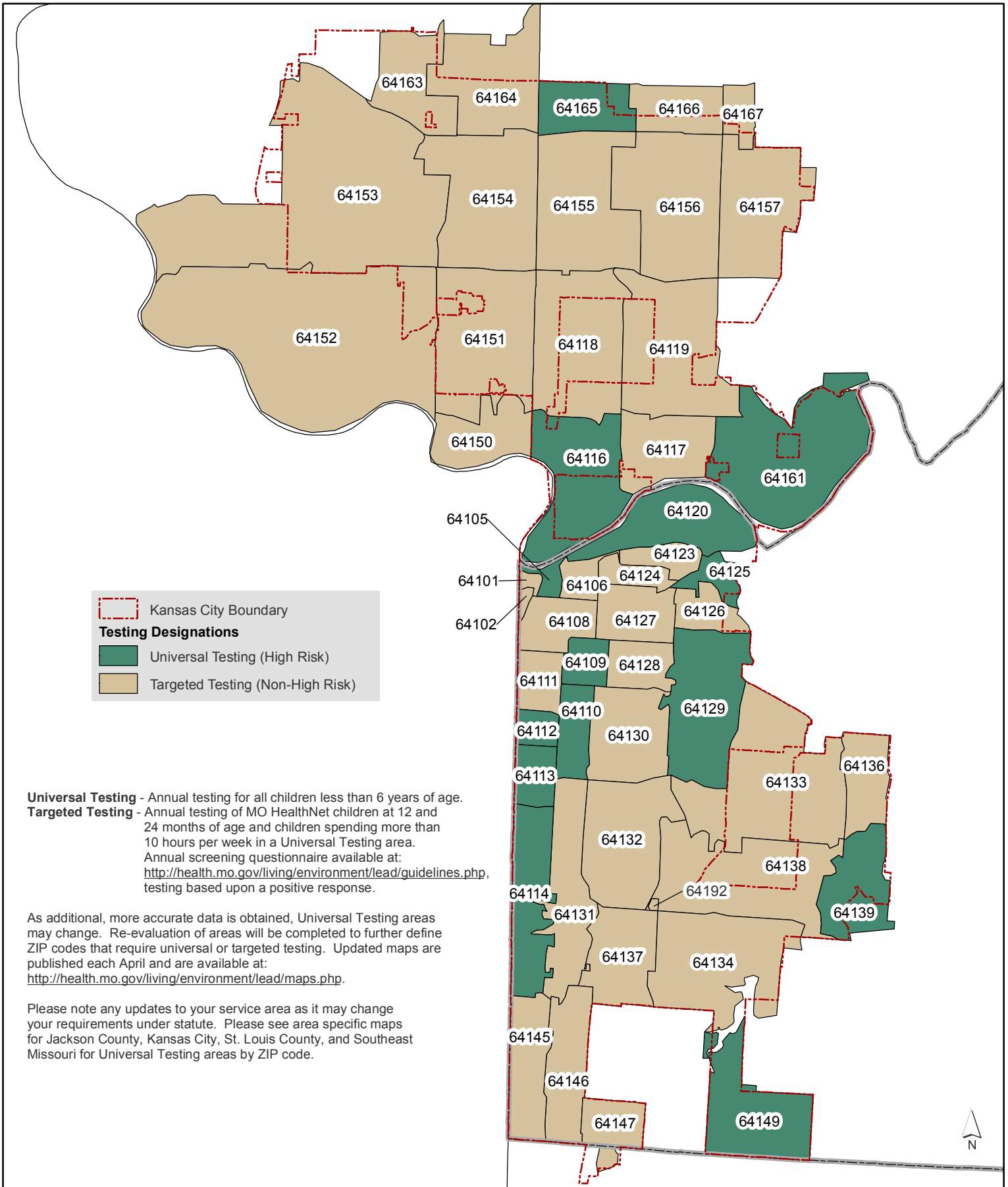




Kansas City Lead Testing Areas April 2011

Testing Designations

- Universal Testing (High Risk)
- Targeted Testing (Non-High Risk)

Universal Testing - Annual testing for all children less than 6 years of age.
Targeted Testing - Annual testing of MO HealthNet children at 12 and 24 months of age and children spending more than 10 hours per week in a Universal Testing area. Annual screening questionnaire available at: <http://health.mo.gov/living/environment/lead/guidelines.php>, testing based upon a positive response.

As additional, more accurate data is obtained, Universal Testing areas may change. Re-evaluation of areas will be completed to further define ZIP codes that require universal or targeted testing. Updated maps are published each April and are available at: <http://health.mo.gov/living/environment/lead/maps.php>.
